## What Is Weatherization?

This a program to help people who have a limited income lower their fuel bills, save energy and have more comfortable homes in the process.

### WEATHERIZATION = INCREASED COMFORT

- ☆ The work is done for those eligible free of charge.
- ☆ Specially trained workers make specified repairs to your home so that it becomes more snug, secure and cheaper to heat and cool.
- ☆ Services include attic and basement insulation, hot water heater and pipe insulation, window and door weatherstripping, caulking, broken glass replacement, glazing.
- ☆ No lien is filed against your home.
- ☆ Also as part of the Weatherization Program your furnace and water heater will be tested for its efficiency and safety. Inefficient or unsafe furnaces will be repaired or replaced. All work is done on an as needed basis.
- ☆ In addition, we provide education on ways you can use and save energy wisely.

## Who Qualifies?

Any York County homeowner or tenant whose income falls below the following guidelines:

Both homeowners and renters are eligible to apply for Weatherization services. Renters need to have the consent of their landlord to participate. The agreement with the landlord contains several conditions including a shared cost requirement for rental properties when furnace repairs exceed \$300.

## Why Apply?

We all need to conserve energy, and it's very helpful to be able to save money at the same time. Weatherization can do both while helping to make your home warmer in winter and cooler in summer.

## Who Pays For This?

The state and federal government through the Department of Energy and the Department of Health and Human Services and the County of York through the York County Planning Commission.

## What's The Catch?

There isn't any. The Weatherization Program has offered these services since 1972 and more than 8500 families have benefitted from taking part in the Program. Homes which have been previously served are not eligible for reservice.

## How Do I Apply?

Just call the York County Planning Commission at 717-771-9870 ask for the Weatherization Program. An application will be sent to you. The time to apply is now.
