

**YORK COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION COALITION MEETING
THURSDAY, JANUARY 17, 2008**

1. Opening Remarks - Representative Saylor opened the meeting at 9:16 am. Representative DePasquale welcomed the group to his district.
2. Minutes from the November 15, 2007 meeting - There being no comments or corrections, the minutes were approved as presented.
3. Presentation - Brandy Heilman gave a brief presentation on the Commuter Services of South Central PA. This program helps commuters and employers in Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Lancaster, Lebanon, Perry, and York Counties find a better way to get to and from work. The Commuter Services program is a public service brought to you by your regional chambers, transit agencies and planning organizations.

After Ms. Heilman's presentation, there was a brief question/answer period. Those topics covered everything from land use issues for municipalities, to pre-tax allowances for transportation and parking, to the policy and funding for this program.

4. Other Business:

- As a refresher and for the new County Commissioner that was present, Ms. Dell gave a brief introduction to the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and purpose of this group, the Transportation Coalition.

The MPO is a federal requirement, because the County is of a certain size. This entity works closely with PennDOT to determine how federal and state transportation funds are prioritized and programmed for the County. The Coalition is a less formal organization and is a good way to get input from and educate stakeholders on transportation topics. The MPO meets quarterly. The Coalition meets every other month.

- 2009-2012 TIP Update - Mr. Clark mentioned that the Technical Committee of the MPO approved a draft of the TIP. The Coordinating Committee will review it next week. After their approval, the draft then goes to PennDOT. The Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) will be completed in June, 2008. Projects will be programmed after the selection criteria is created. The allocation will be approximately \$170 million.

Commissioner Hoke inquired if York County is getting its fair share? Representative Miller answered that we are for transit, not for highway and bridges. During the budget discussions, the rapid growth in our area will be addressed. This could/should lead to an adjustment in the formula used to determine funding. That lead into a discussion on a gas tax, hybrid vehicles, registration fees, etc.


