Dear York County Coalition on Homelessness (York City/County Continuum of Care) grantees, members, and stakeholders:

Below is an important notice regarding the FY 2021 CoC NOFA Competition.

This email summarizes the list of projects that have been accepted by the Coalition (CoC) and will be included in the York City/County CoC Project Priority Listing for funding. This includes renewal projects and new projects that will be submitted, as well as a final notice on projects reduced and rejected.

Please note that the CoC did not reallocate any projects for the FY 2021 CoC NOFA Competition.

Please note that the CoC did reduce one new project application due to insufficient funding available in the FY 2021 competition to award funding in the full amount requested by the applicant.

Please also note that the CoC did reject one new project applications due to insufficient funding available in the FY 2021 competition to award funding to all interested applicants.

All accepted projects are identified on the attached PDF with score, funding amount, and rank. A vote on this ranking proposal was conducted electronically from October 12, 2021 through October 19, 2021. All votes were unanimously in favor of this proposal. The vote has now ended.

Below is the final announcement of accepted projects (new and renewal), as well as reduced and rejected projects.

RENEWAL PROJECTS

The following renewal projects have been recommended by the Coalition (CoC) to be included in the Project Priority Listing submitted to HUD. Each of these projects is recommended for funding at the full Annual Renewal Amount, as indicated on the Coalition's (CoC's) 2021 Grant Inventory Worksheet issued in July 2021. Listed in alphabetical order:

- Bell Socialization Services – York Apartments - \$29,199
- County of York – Continuum of Care RRH Rental Assistance Program - \$72,579
- County of York – CoC RRH Rental Assistance Program for Victims of DV - \$203,940
- County of York – Coordinated Entry - \$120,000

- County of York – Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) - \$147,482
- County of York – York CoC Medium Term RRH - \$162,122
- County of York – York CoC RRH for Survivors of DV - \$195,736
- Housing Authority of the City of York – Shelter Plus Care FY2019 - \$146,604
- Turning Point Interfaith Mission – PH for PWD - \$281,312
- Valley Youth House – York County TH-RRH for Youth - \$113,339
- Valley Youth House – York County RRH for Youth - \$214,335

Total Annual Renewal: \$1,686,648

NEW PROJECTS

The Coalition (CoC) received three (3) new project applications totaling \$527,285 in funding. The Coalition (CoC) has a total of \$480,600 in funding to award. This amount includes funding from the following sources: the CoC Bonus (\$120,150) and the DV Bonus (\$360,450).

None of the three (3) new project applications met the criteria for the DV Bonus.

The following new projects have been accepted for inclusion on the Project Priority Listing for funding. Listed in alphabetical order:

- THE PROGRAM for Female Offenders (dba The Program – It’s About Change) – Housing Assistance New Project - \$100,000 (CoC Bonus)
- Valley Youth House – Expansion of existing York County RRH for Youth - \$20,150 (CoC Bonus)

REDUCED PROJECTS

The Coalition (CoC) had to reduce one (1) new project applications received due to lack of sufficient funds in the FY2021 CoC competition to fund it in its full amount requested.

- Valley Youth House – Expansion of existing York County RRH for Youth
 - Requested: \$188,860
 - Proposed Level of Funding: \$20,150 (CoC Bonus)

REJECTED PROJECTS

The Coalition (CoC) had to reject one (1) of the three new project applications received due to lack of sufficient funds in the FY2021 CoC competition to fund all three. This project was strong, meeting an identified need in our community, but we did not have sufficient funds available to accept it.

- Affordable Housing Advocates – PSH - \$238,425

Planning Grant

Scoring

The CoC's Review & Ranking Procedures allow the Project Funding Evaluation Team (PFET) to rank projects outside of strict score order. Score is only one factor considered by PFET for priority ranking and selection of projects.
