The York Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (YAMPO) announces the start of the public review and comment period on May 19, 2020 for the draft FFY 2021-2024 Transit and Highway Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and draft Air Quality Conformity Analysis (AQCA) Report for York County. Additionally, the TIP update is designed to satisfy rabbittransit's public participation requirements for the Federal program of projects.
