### Virtual Public Open House

#### *GOYORK 2045, Metropolitan Transportation Plan*

The York Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (YAMPO) is holding a **virtual public open house** to answer and discuss your questions and comments on the draft GOYORK 2045, the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) for York County. This document seeks to provide direction for the community in the years 2021 through 2045.


The MTP is an effort to identify and meet the needs of the transportation system within York County, as well as neighboring counties. This document is an overview of the current state of York County, including the performance measures that are tracked yearly, the current plans in place, and maps detailing aspects of the various systems within the county.

Actions adopted by the York Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (YAMPO) are included in the "Moving... *Forward*" sections throughout Chapter 3. Working together with YCPC, rabbittransit, PennDOT, and municipalities, we hope this plan will help you and your neighbors live a better life, however YOU define better.

GOYORK 2045 also offers a glance at the financial side of transportation within the county, including the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) document. Funding revenues and projections are outlined, accounting for inflation and maintenance needs.
