"Section 3 covered project area" is York County in general. Consequently, all Contractors to the greatest extent feasible, should give first consideration to employ low or very low income persons living in, or utilize Section 3 businesses located in York County.

"Section 3 covered project area businesses" as in Title 24 Part 135.5 are businesses that have been identified in York County and defined as:

- ② 51% or more owned by Section 3 Residents, or
- ② 30% of employed staff are Section 3 Residents, or
- ② 25% of subcontracts are committed to Section 3 Businesses

A Section 3 resident is a public housing resident, or resident of a metropolitan area or non-metropolitan county in which the Section 3 covered assistance is expended, and who qualifies as a low-income or very low-income person.
